

Union College and Edgehill College working arrangement.

From September 2009 Union Theological College (UTC) and Edgehill Theological College (ETC) have agreed a new working arrangement. The details of this arrangement are set out below.

1. No charge will be made by UTC for current PhD supervision of ETC staff.
2. Presbyterian and Methodist ministerial students can take modules in UTC and ETC respectively without charge.
3. Presbyterian and Methodist ministerial students who are taking modules in UTC or ETC respectively can have free use of the teaching College library.
4. Module charges will apply for all non-ministerial QUB students taking modules outside their registered College.
5. Current (and new) Methodist ministry students may continue to take the Presbyterian Theological Faculty Ireland BD at UTC. In order to comply with the wording of the UTC Charter, ETC ministry students must formally enrol as UTC students (concurrently with their status as ETC students) and there will be an annual registration and administration fee. Only UTC modules (or approved ETC versions of UTC taught modules) will be acceptable. Examinations will be set and marked by UTC staff and exams will be held in UTC.
6. THE1043 will be team taught by UTC and ETC staff in 2009-10. There may be shared teaching on other modules if there is agreement between the Colleges.
7. Full-time UTC and ETC teaching staff will have reciprocal borrowing privileges in UTC and ETC libraries.

The above working arrangement will be reviewed by the UTC Management Committee in 2012.
