

Accessing audiobooks



To access audiobooks:

- 1. Login via the link and password. Ask library staff for further details if you do not yet have these.
- 2. Click on 'Choose Databases.'




3. Select 'Audiobook Collection (EBSCOhost)' and click 'OK.' The other options can be unselected if you *just* want to search for audiobooks.



4. If you unselected the three other options *only* the Gamble Library's available audiobooks should be listed.






Alternatively, search for the title of the audiobook you are looking for. You can keep all four boxes selected.




5. You need to be signed in with your personal EBSCOhost account to check out an audiobook. (See Searching for journal articles on ATLA databases Gamble Guide for instructions on creating your own EBSCOhost account). Click 'Sign In' on the blue ribbon at the top and enter your Username or email address and Password. Click on the audiobook's title to go into its detailed record. When you are signed in click on 'Borrow' to the left of the screen or under the picture of the book cover.







6. Choose how long you want to borrow the audiobook for and select 'Borrow.'



This message should appear.



7. **Download** the **EBSCO Audiobooks app** from the **App Store** or **Google Play** depending on the device you wish to play the audiobook on.








8. Once it is installed, login to the app with the same Username and Password as you use to login to your EBSCOhost account. Details of the audiobook should appear on your device. Press the play







The first symbol allows you to increase/decrease the speed the audiobook plays at. The second allows you to skip back in the audiobook by 15 seconds. The middle button allows you to play or pause the reading. The third allows you to skip forward in the audiobook by 15 seconds. The final button allows you to see all the chapters. The circle above these symbols can also be pulled along to go to the part you want to.







Pressing this brings up the different chapters in the audiobook and allows you to select any chapter to go straight to it.





9. Once the audiobook has reached the **end of its borrowing period** it will **automatically disappear** from your device. Remember to 'Sign Out' and 'Exit' ATLA databases when you have **finished**. It is not necessary to sign out of the app on your device every time.
