It examines three case studies—Inana and Shukaletuda, The Cuthene Legend of Naram-Sin, and Gilgamesh—arguing that they evince in their self-referential climaxes a distinctly bittersweet notion of textuality, since their creation relies on the tragedy of

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ABSTRACT

This article examines how Philip Melanchthon utilized classical Greek texts in the confessional conflicts of the Reformation. In 1521, Melanchthon published a Greek edition of Aristophanes' *Clouds* as a critique of sophistry, and in 1527 he produced a Latin translation of Demosthenes' speeches *Against Aristogeiton* as a rebuke of Johann Agricola's antinomianism. In the 1540s, when the Reformation came under political pressure from the Holy Roman Empire, Melanchthon used a 1540 edition of Xenophon to plead for political aid from the French crown and a 1547 edition of Demosthenes to critique Charles V's aggression. Finally, in 1548, as Melanchthon came under fire from Catholics and Gnesio-Lutherans, he turned to Athenian oratory

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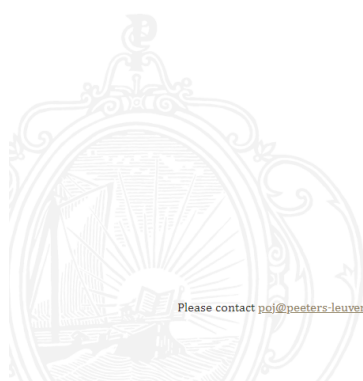
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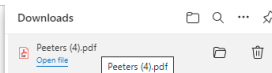

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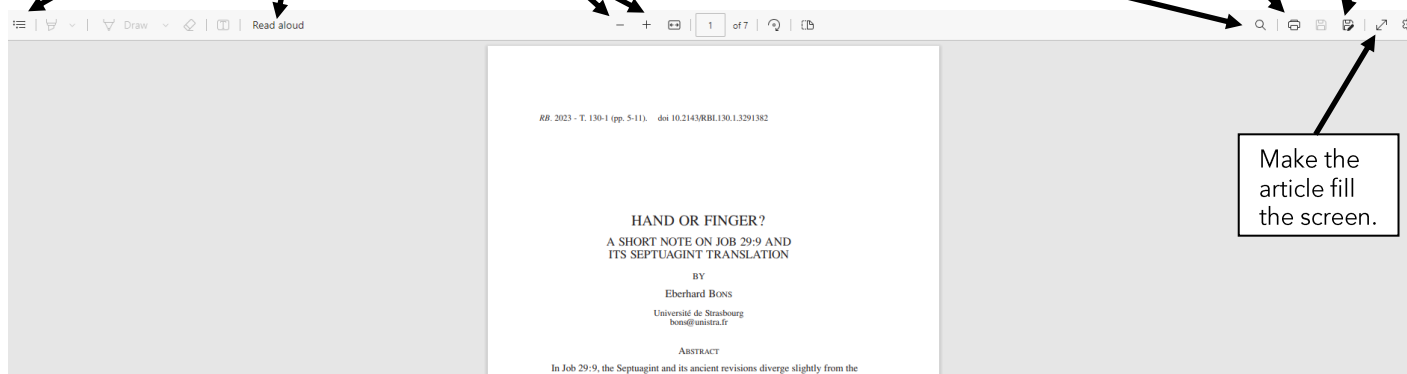
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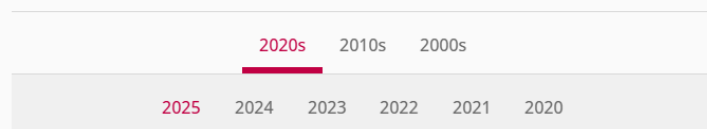
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Open Fields, Stinking Bodies, and Loud Voices: Britishness and Religious Awakenings in Eighteenth-Century Scotland

Abstract

This article interprets the Scottish awakenings through spaces, sounds, and bodies. As southwestern Scots filled late-night, open-air services and repeatedly experienced swooning, screaming, and spectral hauntings, they entered the same 'work' seen throughout the North Atlantic. But the events at Cambuslang and Killybeg were not commonplace replicas of the outpourings seen elsewhere. The spatial, sonic, and corporeal contexts underlying Scotland's revivals show that the awakeners of northern Britain stridently upended the social expectations indispensable to eighteenth-century 'Britishness'. They specifically did so by seizing and retooling long-held stereotypes regarding Scottish bodies and spaces. In doing so, Scotland's born-again clergy and laypeople joined their co-laborers in thoroughly democratizing Protestantism across the British Atlantic.

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Abstract

Job's appeal of innocence in Job 31 may be the most comprehensive depiction of moral goodness found in the Hebrew Bible. In these verses, Job professes his innocence with respect to his relationships in both private and public realms, to God, and to the land. This essay assesses Job's vision of moral integrity in Job 31:1–12, focusing on Job's use of bodily language, including the terms 'heart', 'eyes', 'feet', and 'hands'. The use of such language in Job 31 suggests that moral integrity, for Job, includes both 'interior' (unseen) and 'exterior' (visible) components of his being. This essay brings Job's depiction of moral goodness in conversation with an Aristotelian virtue ethics and demonstrates that, while biblical Hebrew does not contain terms for 'virtue' or 'character', similar notions are present in the biblical text's use of bodily language. Unlike some modern conceptions of virtue or character, however, the biblical text does not depict these concepts as abstract or intangible but as physical and inseparable from the environment of which the moral agent is a part.

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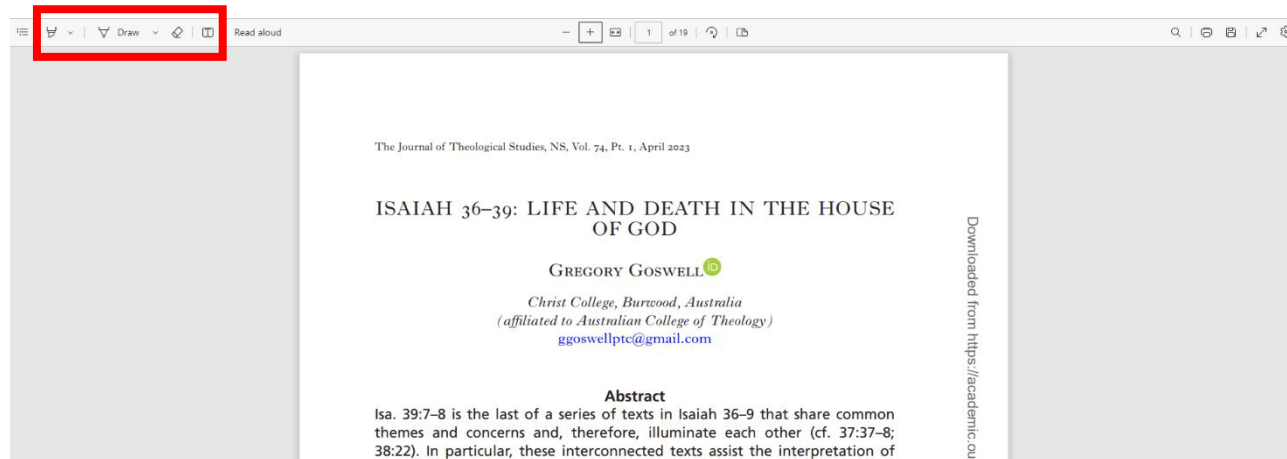
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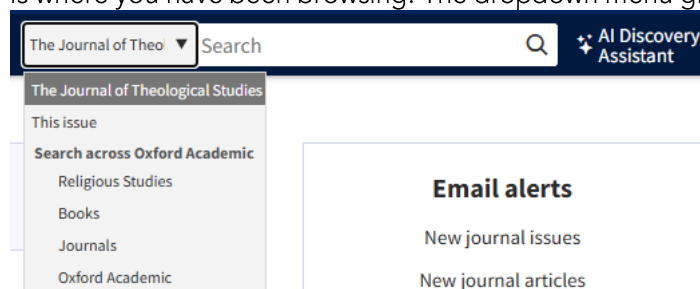


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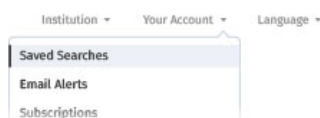
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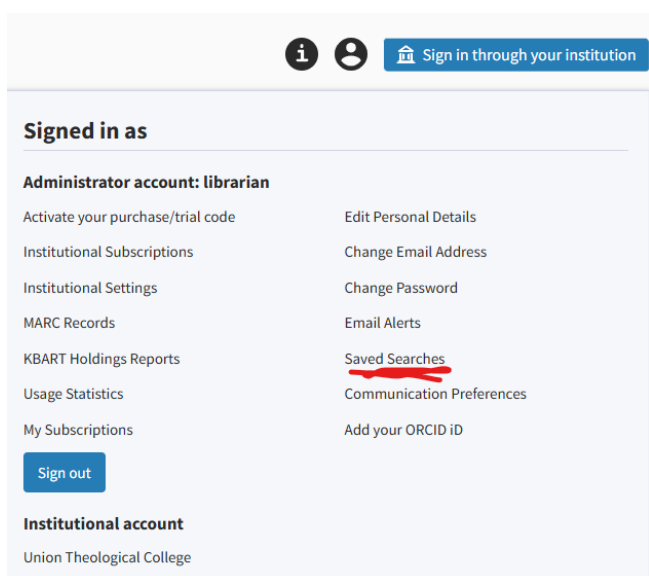


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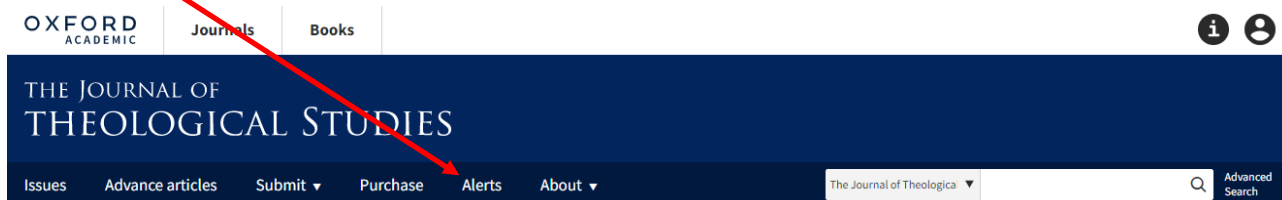
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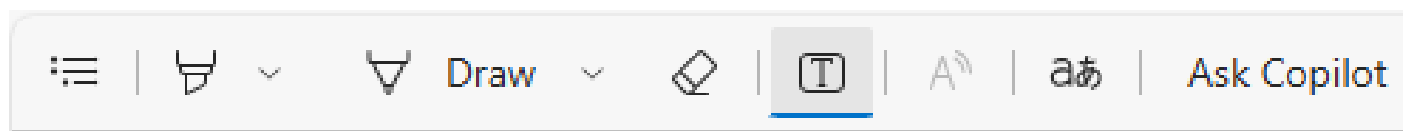
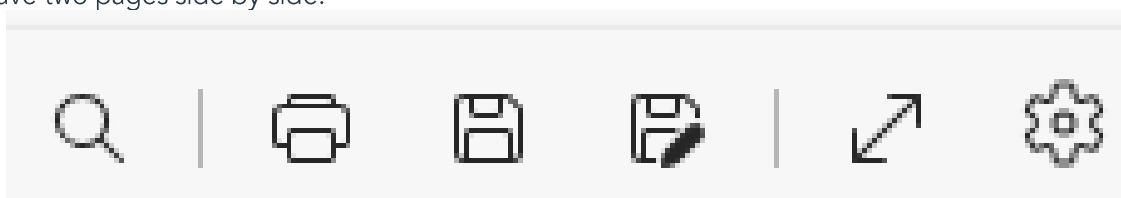


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
