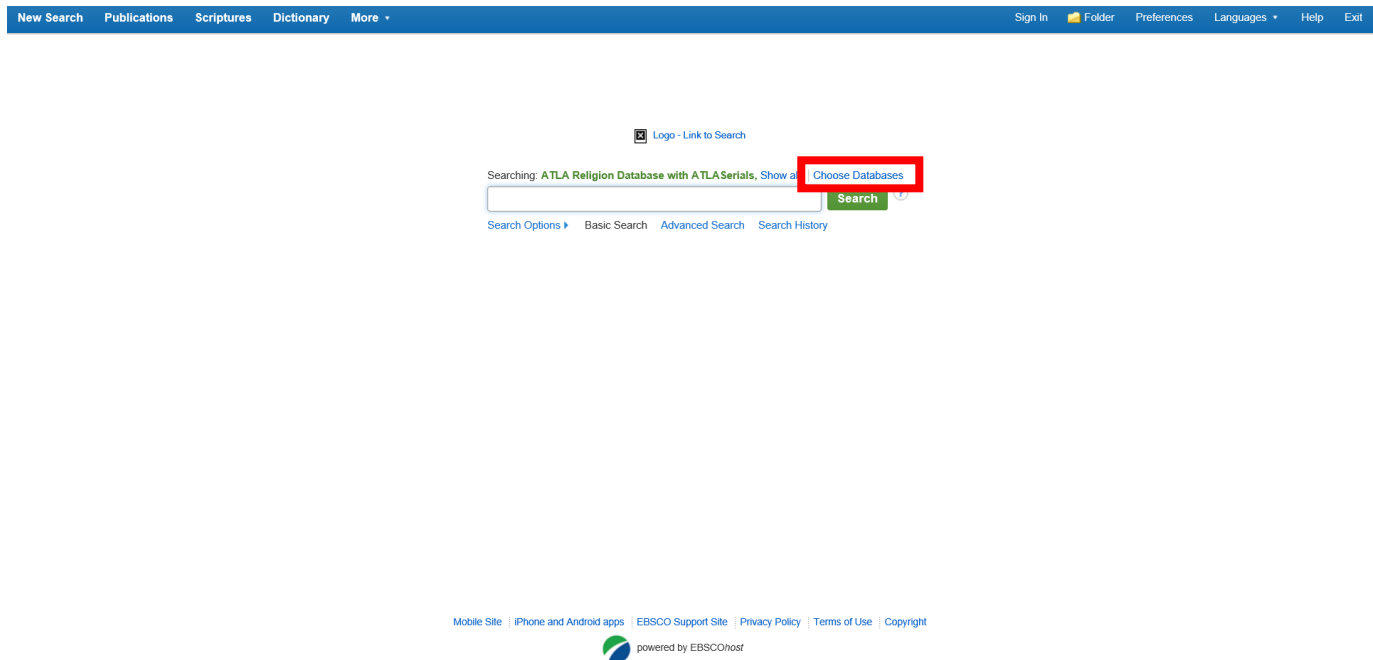


# Accessing audiobooks

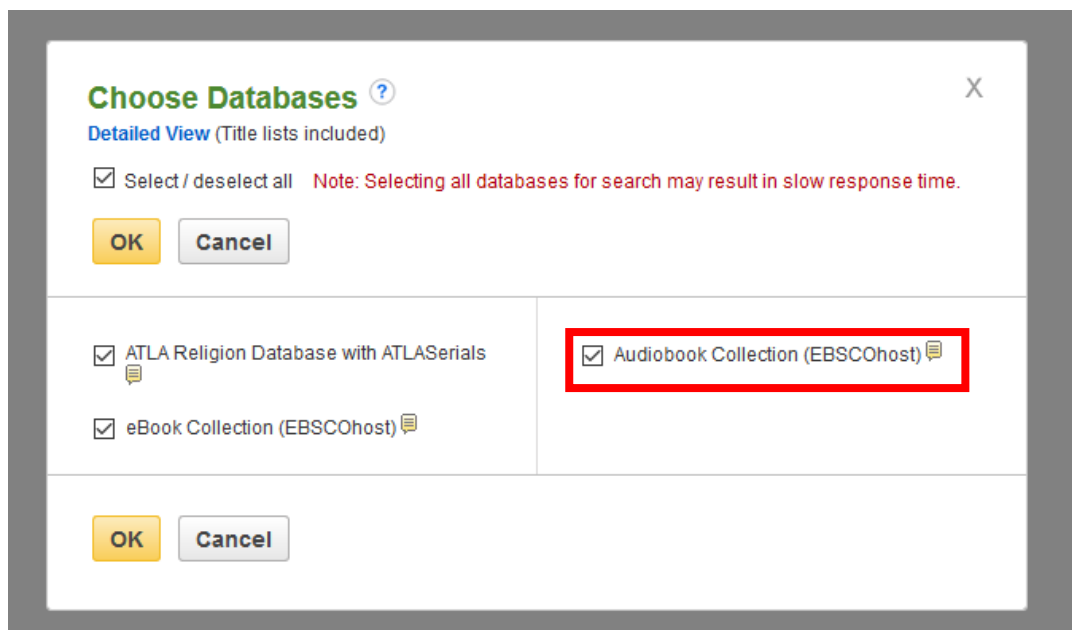

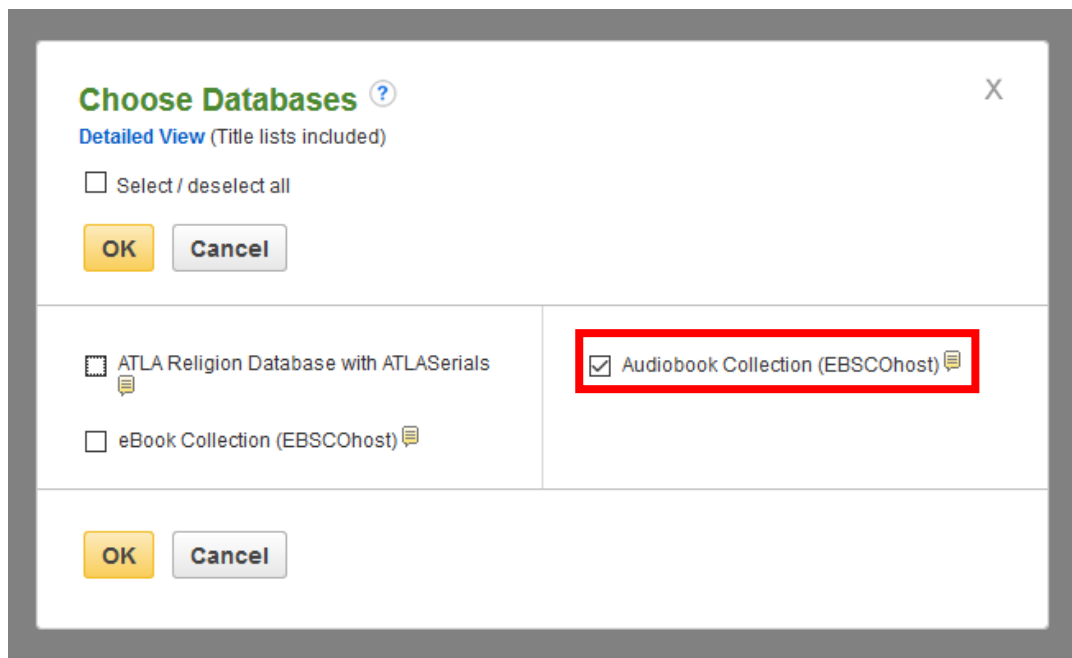
To access audiobooks:

1. **Login** via the **link** and **password**. **Ask library staff** for further details if you do not yet have these.
2. **Click on 'Choose Databases.'**



3. Select **'Audiobook Collection (EBSCOhost)'** and click **'OK.'** **'ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials'** and **'eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)'** can be **unselected** if you just want to search for audiobooks.





4. If you **unselected** 'ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials' and 'eBook Collection (EBSCOhost),' **only** the Library's available audiobooks should be listed.

5. You need to be signed in with your personal EBSCOhost account to check out an audiobook. (See *Searching for journal articles on ATLA databases* Gamble Guide for instructions on creating your own EBSCOhost account). When you are signed in click on **‘Check Out’** under the audiobook’s title, or when you have gone into the audiobook’s detailed record, to the **left of the screen** or **under the picture of the book**. The **detailed record** can be accessed by clicking on the audiobook’s title.

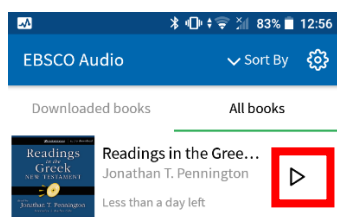
6. Choose how long you want to borrow the audiobook for and select **‘Check Out.’**

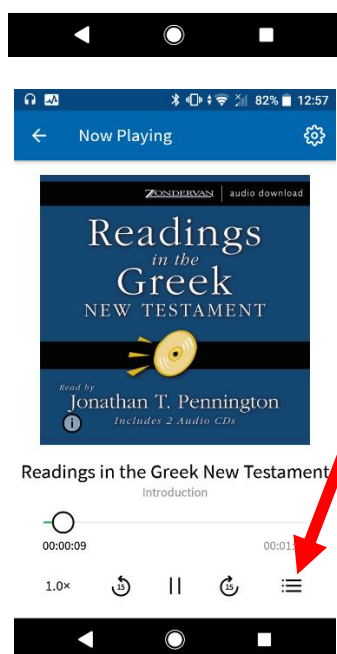
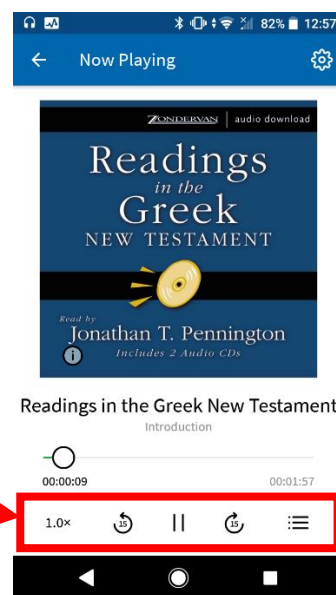

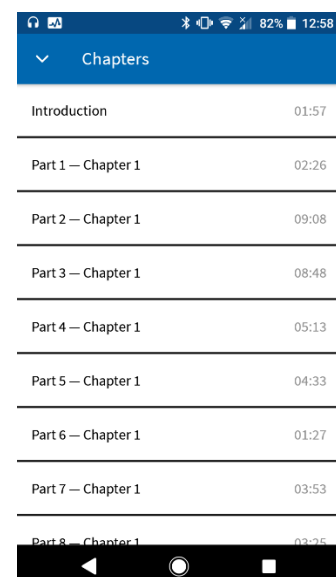
8. Once it is installed, **login** to the app with the **same user name** and **password** as you use to **login to your EBSCOhost account**. **Details** of the **audiobook** should **appear on your device**. Press the **play** symbol to begin listening.



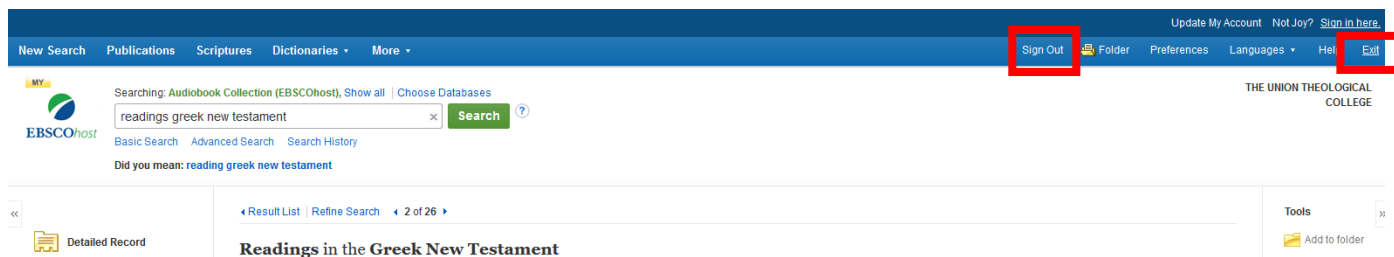
The first symbol allows you to increase/decrease the speed the audiobook plays at. The second allows you to skip back in the audiobook by 15 seconds. The middle button allows you to pause. The third allows you to skip forward in the audiobook by 15 seconds. The final button allows you to see all the chapters. The circle above these symbols can also be pulled along to go to the part you want to.



Pressing this brings up the different chapters in the audiobook and allows you to select any chapter to go straight to it.



9. Once the audiobook has reached the **end of its check out period** it will **automatically disappear** from your device. Remember to **'Sign Out'** and **'Exit'** ATLA databases when you have **finished**. It is not necessary to sign out of the app on your device every time.
