Once you click on the 'EEBO' icon you will be prompted to enter your Union Theological College email address and password. You will then be redirected to the EEBO landing page.

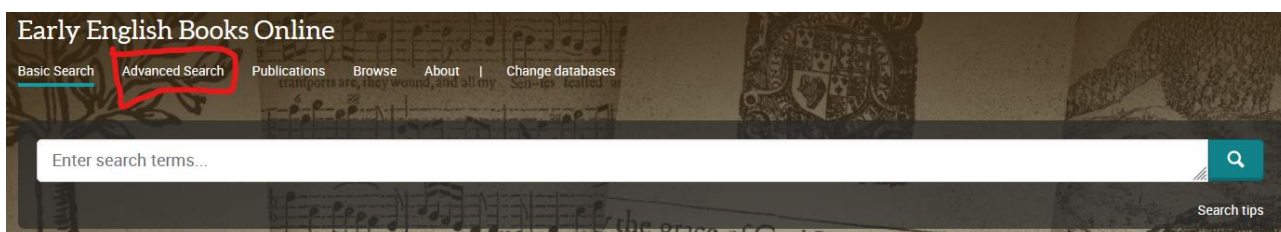
EEBO features page images of almost every work printed in the British Isles and North America, as well as works in English printed elsewhere from 1470-1700. New content is added to EEBO once a year. Transcriptions of texts are also included and several editions of some works.

Basic search

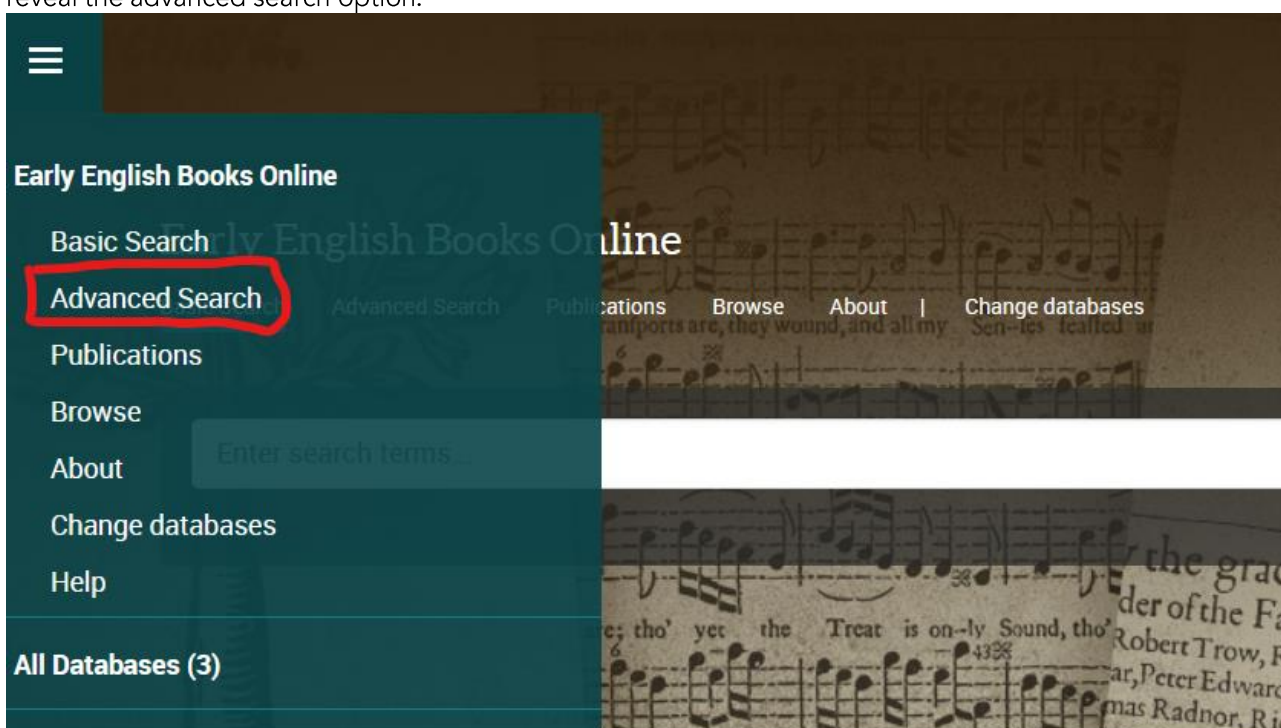
To search, just enter keywords in the search box on the landing page and click the magnifying glass to search:

Please note EEBO ignores stop words like or, the, in. If you enter several words, EEBO searches for all of these in your results. It is possible to use AND OR NOT between your terms. It is better to use the advanced search to get more accurate results.

Advanced search



Click the 'Advanced Search' tab to bring up an advanced search, or click the three lines in the top left to reveal the advanced search option:

Make sure this button is selected to search for spelling variants of your search term. Before English was standardized, there was a variety of ways to spell words. Selecting the button below it returns US/UK spelling variants. Form variants are different forms of the root word, e.g., 'lead' with the form variants button selected searches for leads/leader/leadership/leading etc. Search variants are displayed along the top of the results page.

The Source type can be changed books/journals etc.

The date results can be adjusted by pulling along the markers or entering a specific date range and clicking on 'update.'

You can view all the authors' names and select one to see items written by them only.

(USTC = Universal Short Title Catalogue). Results are also classified by subject and you can select subjects to see only results classified as that subject. 'Subject' gives more detailed subject options.

You can refine results by country or place of publication

You can also refine by publisher, language and the library which the images on EEBO were taken from.

The full text PDF has various tools:

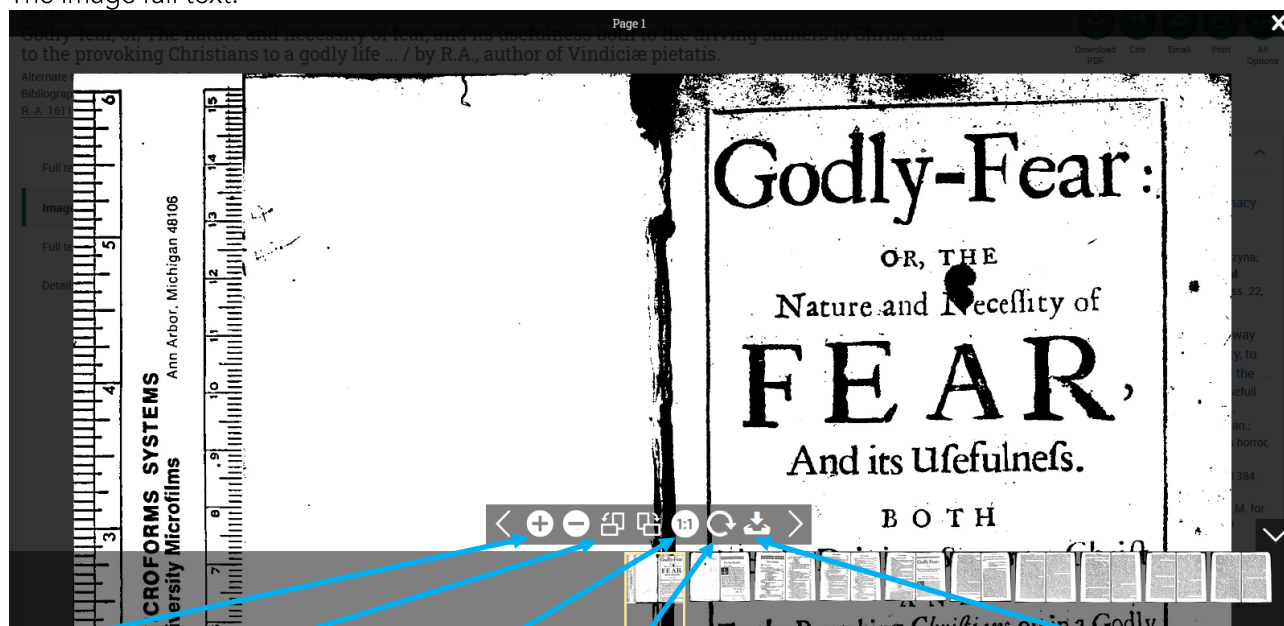
Skip to a page by typing in a number. Search within. Print. Save. Settings. Rotate. Single or double page.



You can see the table of contents.

Highlight, draw, erase and type on the text. Zoom in/out. Fit to page. Have the text read aloud.

The image full text:



Zoom in/out. Rotate the page. True scale. Reset the image to the original size. Download it. You can click any of the thumbnail images along the bottom to go straight to them.

TCP full text page:

'Turn on search term navigation' allows you to use the arrows to move back and forward between keywords. Click 'Hide highlighting' to stop keywords being highlighted.

Keywords are highlighted on the left and you can click any to go straight to them.

With search term navigation on you can see the distribution of keywords.
