


Searching Look4, the online catalogue

Introduction

Look4 is the Gamble Library's online catalogue which contains records for our hardcopy books, pamphlets, journals and E-books. It is available on the search computer in the Library, or at https://union.cirqahosting.com/cirqa-web-app




Basic search

Just type in keywords linked to a subject you are interested in, a distinctive author's name, or words from the title of a book. Click on the magnifying glass or use the enter button on your keyboard to search.




Look4 will display the list view of results so you can see the book title, author, when it was published, where it is shelved and whether it is on loan or not:






Click on the book to see the item's detailed record:






You will then be able to see which room in the Library the item is in, its citation, whether it is on a reading list, its contents if it is an edited book, etc.

The icons on the left allow you to do a range of things:







You can reorder results using the arrow icon. This allows you to reorder results, e.g., in alphabetical order by author surname. The default is by publication date with most recently published books at the top.




This icon allows you to get a permalink to the results, print or download them. The permalink can be shared with others. The results can be downloaded in a range of formats:



Permalink - copy to clipboard Print out this/these items Download this/these items


If you login to the online catalogue with your reader code and password, you have more options:



The 'Checking loans on the online catalogue' Gamble Guide explains how to set your own password if you have not done so already.


'Add to favourites' is very useful. You can add searches to your favourites and then share these with others. To view and share favourites, click on the three lines menu icon and 'View favourites':






You can view your searches and get a hyperlink to a search at the chain icon or delete a saved search at the X.








Basic searches can be used to search for module reading lists if you know the module code. E.g., THY4005 is the code for Early Church History:






Build a search

Basic searches give many results which may not always be relevant so the option to 'Build a search' should be used regularly. Click on 'Build a search' and enter the terms you are interested in, e.g., words in the title, author's surname, the name of a book or pamphlet series, media type such as e-book, etc.:






To access an E-book from the online catalogue, make sure you are logged into Atla in another tab.



Click on 'Read me' or the URL link in the citation.

Click on 'Access now (eBook)' to start reading the e-book. (Sometimes you will have the option to choose between the PDF or EPUB version of the e-book):





Search tips

- When searching if you enter up to three words, only records containing all of them will be returned.
- If you enter four or more words it will return records containing all or most of them. If you are using the basic search the terms may be located anywhere in the record, e.g., in the title, author, subject fields or anywhere on the record.
- You can search for a phrase using quotation marks, e.g., "Synoptic Gospels"
- Terms can be combined using AND, OR and AND NOT.
- Linking terms with AND returns only those records that contain both terms
- Linking terms with OR returns records that contain either or both terms
- Linking terms with AND NOT returns records that include the first term, and excludes those records which also contain the second term.
- Complex searches can be created using AND, OR and AND NOT. Use brackets () to ensure that they are interpreted in the correct order. E.g., (Scotland OR Ireland) AND Reformation, finds records containing Reformation, plus either Scotland, Ireland, or both.
- If you enter a phrase within quotation marks, any AND, OR or AND NOT will not be interpreted as above. E.g., "For love or honour" will only return records containing that exact phrase.
- Wildcards can be used. The wildcard ? is used to replace a single character. The wildcard * may be used to replace one or more consecutive characters.

If you click on 'The Gamble Library' or home icon, you are taken back to the homepage and can search again.


