Union College seeks to respond positively to the views of students with regard to issues that will improve our students' experience of studying and learning. Here are some ways in which we have responded to issues raised by our students this year.

You said

.... that some students (20%) were not clear about the student support arrangements that were in place to help and advise students during their studies at Union.

We did

.....make an extra effort during Welcome Week to ensure that everyone knew about the peer mentoring programme and the Personal Tutor programme. During the first two weeks of Semester 1 all students were invited to a meeting with their Personal Tutor, and in mid-semester there were group meetings of Personal Tutor groups.

The Faculty have prepared a Personal Tutor handbook to help them give important and relevant support to each student in their group.

.....that you would like to be able to print wirelessly from your own devices in the library.

We did

.... provide wireless printing facilities in the library for all students.

You said.....

.....that you would like more information on the review process carried out by the University and the implications for current students.

We did

.... commit to relaying this concern to the University.

You said

..... that you would like to be more actively involved in the planning and leading of Worship times in the College.

We did

..... hand over the planning and leading of the Thursday morning Worship time to a group of students. It has been a great success and a significantly higher number of students have been attending and appreciating this event.

You said

..... that you would like recycling facilities on site.

We did

..... place recycling bins in the common room.
